



# 2021 ZESTINO TIRES NSW SUPERSPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

# PART 2

## 2.1 Two Competitions

These Supplementary Regulations are for a single event that includes two (2) competitions, which are a National Competition being a Round of the NSW State Supersprint Championship ("the Championship") and a Multi-Club Competition being a Multi-Club Supersprint ("the Multi-Club Supersprint"). All of the Supplementary Regulations apply equally to both competitions with the exception of those regulations that specifically state that they apply to just one or the other.

- 2.3 Venue: SYDNEY MOTOR SPORT PARK GARDNER CIRCUIT (GP)

### 2.6 Track

**Surface:** Bitumen / Length: 3.93klm / Direction: Anti-Clockwise / Boundary: Drivers who drive off the competition surface as defined by the white line on the outer edge of the track with all 4 wheels will be deemed to have left the circuit and may have their times for that session forfeited.

## 2.8 Drivers' Briefing

There will be no pre-event Drivers' Briefing. Drivers Briefing notes will be distributed electronically to all Drivers and acknowledgement of them must be submitted to the Event Secretary electronically by <u>no later than two days after the Event Closing Date</u>.

#### 2.9 Number of Laps

Each run will comprise a minimum time to allow all competitors to complete at least 3 timed laps, with the time for the fastest single lap being used for results. The minimum time for each run will be 8 Minutes. The proposed minimum number of runs on the day will be: 4

(Note: The Event will not be concluded when this minimum is achieved. Event will only be concluded early for safety reasons or if no competitors available)

#### 2.10 Entries

- a) Maximum number of Driver entries for the Event: 120 Reserves: 10
- b) Maximum number of Drivers per car 2. Dual entry of drivers in Type 1 will be at the discretion of the organising club.
- c) Drivers must be a financial member of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Car Club on the date of the Event and complete a declaration to that effect in the entry **Disclaimer form SSP 06 / 20/V1**.
- d) Vehicles competing in the NSW Supersprint Championship must either be currently road registered (incl. Historic & Classic) and/or be issued with a Motorsport Australia log book.
- e) Vehicles in the Multi Club Supersprint will not be eligible to score Championship points and must run under a competition number in the 900 999 range.
- f) Preferential Opening Date for Championship Registrants: 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2021
- g) General Opening Date: 16th March 2021
- h) Entry Fee \$ ARDC Members \$260 Non Members \$280
- i) Timing Transponder hire if required \$ 16.50
- j) Entry Closing Date: Wednesday 31st March Late Entry Closing Date: Sunday 4th APRIL 2021
- k) A Late Entry Fee of \$ ARDC Members \$280 Non Members \$290 will apply for entries received after the Entry closing date.
- I) A pit usage fee of \$ 25 per garage Each garage will take 2 vehicles will apply. Carports \$ 10.
- m) Entries will be accepted in order of receipt electronically together with the appropriate payment as required.
- n) Entries from Drivers between 14 and 18 years of age must have consent signed by a parent or legal guardian on the entry **Disclaimer form SSP 06 / 20/V1**.

#### 2.11 Event Schedule

There will be no in-person document checks. Documents (Declarations etc) <u>must be received electronically no later than two days after the Event Closing Date</u> and will be checked prior to the event.

Event Start time: 0900Hrs Event Finish time: 1630Hrs

#### 2.12 Drivers Code of Conduct

Penalties for breaches of the Drivers Code of Conduct included in SSP 02 Sporting Regulations may apply.

#### 2.13 Scrutineering

There will be no pre-event scrutineering at the Circuit, with the exception of vehicle's entered into the Multi Club Event that are not road registered and do not have a Motorsport Australia Log Book. A self-scrutiny vehicle safety check must be performed by the competitor and driver.

Scrutiny Checklist Speed, is integrated into the ARDC Online Entry System. This must be completed online and signed appropriately with your normal signature.

Competitors must present themselves to Scrutineering with their Log Book and Proof of Vehicle Registration (as applicable) to have their Scrutineering windscreen sticker issued.

Please note that scrutineers may conduct pre event scrutineering and spot checks through the day whilst maintaining distancing and non-contact protocols. If a non-compliance is found the Driver/Competitor will be referred to the Clerk of the Course.

#### **2.14** Prizes / Awards (Multi Club Supersprint competitors not included)

- a) Outright 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- Zestino Trophy for 1<sup>st</sup> Place in Class (Championship only classes with 3 or more competitors).

## 2.17 COVID-19 Special Conditions

- a) Under no circumstances may anyone attend an event if any of the following apply:
  - a. Have any symptoms consistent with COVD-19 such as higher temperature, respiratory issues, shortness of breath, sore throat, lack of sense of small, fatigue
  - b. Been overseas in the previous 14 days
  - c. Been in contact with a known COVID-19 positive case in the previous 14 days
- b) Spectators are not permitted.
- c) COVIDSafe app should be installed and open on mobile phones
- d) Sharing of tools, equipment and apparel is to be avoided. If sharing is unavoidable, the equipment must be cleaned prior to use by another person.
- e) The sharing of food is to be avoided.
- f) Social distancing as required by Governments is to be maintained.
- g) Comply with any requests by the COVID-19 Event Checker. Note that the event will not commence with the COVID-19 Event Checker's authorisation.
- h) A maximum of 3 pit crew are permitted, however competitors are requested to limit to essential personnel only.
- i) Competitors and pit crew must acknowledge the COVID-19 Venue Plan for the event.
- i) Other conditions: None

#### 2.18 Supplementary Regulations Part 1

Supplementary Regulations provide information to competitors and drivers in addition to those which are contained in the Motorsport Australia National Competition Rules and the Motorsport Australia Manual. Part 1 of these Supplementary Regulations contains regulations that remain the same for each round this year.
