1. EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

- 1.1 Event Title: 2023 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA NSW Motor Race Championship **ROUND 6** at Sydney Motorsport Park
This will be a **2 DAY RACE EVENT**.
- 1.2 Date: **SATURDAY 28TH & SUNDAY 29TH OCTOBER 2023**
- 1.3 Venue: **Sydney Motor Sport Park, – the 3.9 km Gardner (GP) Circuit will be used.**

2. ORGANISATION AND STATUS

- 2.1 The Event shall be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules. (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Circuit Race Standing Regulations (CRSR) published by Motorsport Australia, relevant Championship and/or Series Sporting and Technical Regulations as approved by Motorsport Australia, these Supplementary Regulations, and any Further Regulations and instructions to Competitors that may be issued.
- 2.2 The Event shall be a **NSW State Motor Race Championship Event**, with races for the invited categories.
- 2.3 The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at <https://www.motorsport.org.au/regulations/safety-integrity/policies>

4. MEDICAL

Medical requirements will be in accordance with Article 3.1.4.3 Alternative Medical Service/Requirements of the Motorsport Australia Medical Service Requirements at Motor Sport Events.

5. CIRCUIT DETAILS

- a) Length: 3.9 km
b) Direction: Anti - Clockwise
c) Track Density: The maximum number of starters permitted in any race will be in accordance with Motorsport Australia guidelines.

6. My Laps Race Control Management System

The fitting of a MyLaps unit is now **mandatory** when participating in any track activity at SMSP.

It should be made clear that this unit has **NO REGULATORY IMPLICATION** regarding Motorsport Australia. It is a device to assist in the management of the track between Marshal Posts and as an advisory device for the driver.

- The units remain at all times the property of ARDC.
- It is the Competitors responsibility to ensure adequate fitting to the vehicle using the materials provided.
- As this unit for the driver is advisory, there is no restriction as to it being placed in view of the driver, simply a secure place on the vehicle that can transmit a valid signal.
- Should the unit fail to be observed during any session on track, the competitor will be advised post session and steps taken to ensure there is a fully functioning unit attached to the vehicle prior to any subsequent sessions.
- There is **NO** additional charge, for the use of the unit at this event.
- Unit can be picked up and returned to the Main Office at the base of the Control Tower.
- Should a competitor leave the venue without returning the unit, the safe return of the unit, in full working order, will be at the full expense of the Competitor and must be **received** by ARDC **within a 2-week period**.
- **Failure to return** the unit within the 2-week period or at all, will result in the competitor being invoiced for a replacement unit. **(\$1500)**.

f) The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any Competitor in accordance with the NCR.

8. EVENTS

- 7.1 These races will be held in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Manual and the relevant Sporting & Technical Regulations and appendices for 2023.
7.2 Races will be conducted for vehicles complying with Regulations for the following, Formula Ford (45), Formula Cars (38), Formula Vee (54), HQ Holdens (54) Production Touring (Enduro) (54), RX-8 Cup (54), Sports Sedans (37), SuperKarts (60) (Sun Only), SuperSports (38) (Sat Only),

- 8.3 In order to maximise track time and racing laps for all categories, ARDC in consultation with Motorsport Australia reserve the right to combine events. This will be done with due consideration to the State Championships and the categories concerned. Any such combination will be advised in the Race Event Schedule.
- 8.4 Qualifying will take place on Saturday 28th of OCTOBER 2023.
The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

9. LICENCE & MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- 9.1 Competitors must hold a current Motorsport Australia-Affiliated Sporting Car Club Membership unless they comply with 8.2.1 or 8.2.2 below.
- 9.2 If the Competitor for this event is NOT the OWNER OF THE VEHICLE, the relevant form must be completed and emailed to race@ardc.com.au. This may be done by the Competitor sending the form from the ARDC Online EES, or to the please follow the link, complete, and submit the **Automobile Legal Owner's Declaration**.

- 9.3 Each Driver must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Provisional Endorsed Circuit licence, unless noted otherwise against a particular Event or specified otherwise in the Sporting Regulations for the relevant category Championship/Series or;
- 9.3.1 Hold a Motor Sport New Zealand competition licence and valid Tasman Visa for the event or
- 9.3.2 Hold the minimum of the highest-grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN required for the Event and obtain approval to compete from the ASN that issued their licence. Each such Driver and Competitor:
- 9.3.2.1 Will be ineligible to score points in a Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy etc. connected with the Event: and
- 9.3.2.2 Shall be required to receive an authorisation to compete from Motorsport Australia prior to the Event

10. AWARDS/PRIZES

Awards for this Event will be in the form of trophies and will be provided by the Organiser. They will be awarded as per the relevant category Sporting Regulations, approved by Motorsport Australia for 2023, and in conjunction with the 2023 Motorsport Australia NSW Motor Race Championship Sporting Regulations Chapter 3 – Awards and Pointscores. **Round Awards will be presented on the day on the ARDC/SMSP PODIUM, AFTER THE RACE AFTER THEIRS.**

11. AUTOMATIC TIMING

The Organisers utilise an automatic timing system that requires all cars to be fitted with a Data 1 transmitter. Competitors must provide the transmitter. Transmitters are available from Dorian Industries, Factory 1, 29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing VIC, 3029. Phone: + 61 3 9931 1371.

12. PRIVATE PRACTICE AVAILABILITY

Sydney Motor Sport Park is available for Private Practice on **Friday 27TH OCTOBER 2023**.
Entry for Private Practice can be made **during** the Online Entry System process, **WHILST ENTRIES ARE OPEN**.
The GST inclusive cost is **\$220** per day or **\$190** per day to members of **the A.R.D.C.**
Entry **can** be made on the day at a cost of **\$260** per day, or **\$230** per day to members of the A.R.D.C.

13. GARAGE AND PADDOCK ALLOCATION

The On-line Entry System allows the BOOKING & REQUESTING of Garages and Carports. **ARDC members are given 1st offer of Garages**, ie they can **BOOK** a garage. Non-members are only allowed to **REQUEST** a Garage initially. (If you do receive a Garage, it is recommended that you bring your own padlock).

14. CREDENTIALS

All **Sprint** Competitors should enter Sydney Motor Sport Park via Gate A off Ferrers Road.
4 Tickets PER VEHICLE, will be made available for Pit Crew, including the Driver. This may be updated in any Further Supplementary Regulations that may be issued for this event. **Enduro** categories will receive 6.

Pit Lane wristband passes can be issued at Friday practice and will be valid all weekend. All Pit Crew **MUST** wear their wristbands at **ALL** times while in a **RESTRICTED AREA, ie, PIT LANE, MARSHALLING AREA**. All persons NOT wearing a Pit Crew wristband, will be removed from the area, and directed to the Race Secretaries office at the bottom of the Control Tower to obtain one. There will be **NO** exceptions.

If you need to withdraw your entry you must advise the ARDC in writing no later than 17:00hrs on **Monday 30TH OCTOBER 2023**. COB 17:00hrs. The ARDC will not consider refunds unless this requirement is strictly adhered to. A \$25.00 administration fee will be charged for ALL withdrawals. If a competitor pays to attend Friday practice then suffers a mechanical failure which prevents them racing the ARDC will refund 50% of the race Entry Fee if advised in person or email **before 17:00hrs Friday 27th OCTOBER 2023**.

15. TARGETED SCRUTINY

Scrutiny at this event will be undertaken under the Motorsport Australia Targeted Scrutiny process.

14.1 If there is a requirement for the **Vehicle Owner's Declaration** to be needed, it **must be FILLED IN AND SUBMITTED PRIOR TO THE CLOSING DATE FOR THE EVENT.**

All vehicles must comply with the relevant requirements for their category. The Chief Scrutineer for the Event will determine which vehicles will be audited and those Competitors will be advised of a time in which the audit will occur at Event Documentation Scrutiny. A Motorsport Australia Vehicle Log Book must be presented. Competitors and Drivers must comply with the Motorsport Australia requirements at the time of entry.

All Competitors must wear apparel in compliance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual. All footwear, socks and gloves must comply with FIA 8856-2000 standard.

16. FUEL

98Ron, Elf Race 102 and commercial E85 fuel are available via bowser at all times. The maximum amount of fuel to be stored in each Garage is 250 litres.

a) Refuelling is not allowed in Pit Lane or in Pit Garages whilst participating in a race or session. Any refuelling done outside this period, must be done in the following manner;

- Both garage doors must be open
- No open flame or ANY type of cigarette can be present
- A fire extinguisher must be present under the control of a person appropriately dressed for the function. It fully covered in neck/ankle in non-flammable/flame retardant material.

17. INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity, and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au

18. PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with of the NCR.

19. INTEGRITY, ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
