SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

PART 2

2.1 Two Competitions

These Supplementary Regulations are for a single event that includes two (2) competitions, a State Competition being a round of the Motorsport Australia Pro Speed Racing NSW State Supersprint Championship ("Championship") and a Club Competition being a round of the Motorsport Australia Pro Speed Racing NSW Club Supersprint Series ("Club Series"). All of the Supplementary Regulations apply equally to both competitions except for those regulations that specifically state that they apply to just one or the other.

2.2 Date: 19th July 2026 **Day:** Sunday

2.3 Venue: Sydney Motorsport Park Gardner (GP) Circuit

Location: Eastern Creek NSW

2.4 Promoter/Organising Club: Australian Racing Drivers Club (ARDC)

2.5 Motorsport Australia Permit No: 226/1907/01

2.6 Track

Surface: Bitumen / **Length:** 3.93KM / **Direction:** Anti-Clockwise / **Boundary:** Drivers who drive off the competition surface as defined by the solid line on the outer edge of the track with all 4 wheels will be deemed to have left the circuit and may have their lap times for that session forfeited.

2.8 Drivers' Briefing

Drivers Briefing Notes will be available digitally via email to all Competitors and must be read prior to the Event.

Additionally, a compulsory Drivers Briefing covering key aspects of the day will be held at (time): 08:15 AM and (location): Hinxman Room.

2.9 Number of Laps

Each run will comprise **a minimum time to allow all competitors to complete at least 3 timed laps**, with the time for the fastest single lap being used for results. **The minimum time for each run will be 8 Minutes.** The proposed **minimum number of runs per vehicle on the day will be: 3 Runs per Vehicle**

(Note: The Event will not be concluded when this minimum is achieved. Event will only be concluded early for safety reasons or if no competitors available)

2.10 Entries

- a) Maximum number of Driver entries for the Event: 120 Reserves: 10
- b) Maximum number of Drivers per car 2. Dual entry of drivers in Type 1S will be at the discretion of the organising club.
- c) Drivers must be a financial member of a Motorsport Australia Affiliated Sporting Car Club on the date of the Event.
- d) Vehicles competing in the Championship must either be currently road registered (incl. Historic & Classic) and/or be issued with a Motorsport Australia log book. Club Series competitors are exempt from this requirement.
- e) Vehicles that do not have a registered Championship or Club Series competition number will compete in the Club Series as "privateers" and will have a temporary competition number allocated to them for this event only.
- f) Preferential Opening Date for Championship and Club Series Registrants: Monday 25th May 2026
- g) General Opening Date for privateer entries: Monday 8th June 2026
- h) Entry Fee \$ **EARLY BIRD DISCOUNTED FEE:** \$325 ARDC MEMBERS \$345 NON ARDC MEMBERS
\$ **REGULAR ENTRY FEE:** \$350 ARDC MEMBERS \$ 370 NON ARDC MEMBERS
- i) Timing Transponder hire (MYLAPS) if required \$ 35
- j) Entry Closing Date: Sunday 5th July 2026 Late Entry Closing Date: Sunday 12th July 2026
- k) A Late Entry Fee of \$ 25 will apply for entries received after the Entry closing date.
- l) A pit usage fee of \$ 30 per garage will apply. Carports are FREE OF CHARGE .
- m) **An entry consists of (1) the submission of an online Event Entry through the ARDC Competitors Portal AND (2) the submission of an online Motorsport Australia Risk Warning, Disclaimer, Indemnity and Statement of Vehicle Compliance. Please note that both Motorsport Australia forms will be provided in the ARDC online Event Entry process.** Entries must contain both submissions and will be accepted in order of receipt electronically together with the appropriate payment as required.
- n) Entries from Drivers between 14 and 18 years of age must have consent signed by a parent or legal guardian. There is an option to select this through the ARDC online Event Entry process. Once selected, the organisers (ARDC) will be notified and will send out the appropriate documentation.
- o) Vehicles competing in the Championship will be issued with a sticker denoting their Type to be displayed on the rear window and kept there, if possible, for the entire Championship season.

2.11 Event Schedule

Venue gates open: 06:00 AM **Scrutineering Check-in commences:** 07:00 AM

Event Start time: 09:00 AM **Event Finish time:** 16:30 PM

2.12 Drivers Code of Conduct

Penalties for breaches of the Drivers Code of Conduct included in **SSP 02 Sporting Regulations** may apply.

2.13 Scrutineering

- a) Scrutineering/Check-in will commence at 07:00 AM and will cease at 09:30 AM. No Scrutineering/Check-in will take place during the Drivers Briefing.
- b) Competitors **must** perform a vehicle check prior to the Event to ensure compliance with the scrutineering requirements of Section 1.10 in Part 1 of these Supplementary Regulations, in particular section 1.10(p) to ensure that any non mechanically attached device is securely tethered.
- c) Competitors issued with a **yellow** "Audit Required" windscreen sticker are required to present themselves and their vehicle to scrutineering for a self-extraction test and scrutineering audit between 9:30am and 1:00pm. If a non-compliance is found, the Driver/Competitor may be referred to the Clerk of the Course. Please refer to [SSP 20 Scrutineering Reference Sheet](#) for the items that will be subject to audit.

- d) Privateer competitors (ie those without a registered competition number) whose vehicle do not have a log book will be issued with a **red** "Audit Required" windscreen sticker and are required to bring their vehicle to the scrutineering bay for inspection prior to 9:30am.
- e) Vehicles that have a Motorsport Australia Logbook will be subject to the Targeted Scrutiny system, and those requiring an audit will be issued with a **yellow** "Audit Required" windscreen sticker.
- f) **Sponsors "Tow" stickers will be provided free of charge** and must be displayed on every vehicle competing indicating the positions of the front and rear tow point.]

A completed Risk Warning, Disclaimer, Indemnity & Statement of Vehicle Compliance must be submitted online to the Organisers no later than the Event Closing Date.

Competitors must first present themselves at Scrutineering Check-in with their (1) helmets & FHR (if used), (2) Logbook (if applicable) and (3) photo identification to Scrutineering Check-in to have their scrutineering windscreen sticker and drivers wrist band issued.

2.14 Affiliated Sporting Car Club Membership

Competitors must be a current financial member of a Motorsport Australia affiliated sporting car club.

2.15 Circuit Specific Requirements

2.16 Prizes / Awards

a) **Championship registrants** are awarded points for both Type and Class in the 2026 Motorsport Australia NSW Supersprint Championships as detailed in the 2026 Sporting Regulations. The 2026 Trophy Presentation is planned to be held during the Drivers Briefing at Round 1 in 2027.

b) Club Series competitors will have the results of this event included in their Club's competition if applicable, with any prizes or awards presented at the individual Club's discretion.

c) Additional Prizes and Awards may be presented at the discretion of the NSW Supersprint Panel and relevant sponsor.

2.19 My Laps Race Control Management System

The fitting of a MyLaps unit is now **mandatory** when participating in any track activity at SMSP.

It should be made clear that this unit has **NO REGULATORY IMPLICATION** regarding Motorsport Australia. It is a device to assist in the management of the track between Marshal Posts and as an advisory device for the driver.

- The units remain at all times the property of ARDC.
- It is the Competitors responsibility to ensure adequate fitting to the vehicle using the materials provided.
- As this unit for the driver is advisory, there is no requirement as to it being placed in view of the driver, simply a secure place on the vehicle that can transmit a valid signal.
- Should the unit fail to be observed during any session on track, the competitor will be advised post session and steps taken to ensure there is a fully functioning unit attached to the vehicle prior to any subsequent sessions.
- There is **NO** additional charge, for the use of the unit at this Event.
- Unit can be picked up and returned to the Main Office at the base of the Control Tower, which must be done at the beginning and end of each day, to ensure that unit is adequately charged for use.
- There is now available a cable than can be hard wired into the vehicle for the purposes of charging. This can be purchased from ARDC @ SMSP and is a **onetime purchase cost of \$20**. Please contact ARDC for details.
- Should a competitor leave the venue without returning the unit, the safe return of the unit, in full working order, will be at the full expense of the Competitor and must be **received** by ARDC **within a 2-week period**.
- **Failure to return** the unit within the 2-week period or at all, will result in the competitor being

invoiced for a replacement unit. **(\$1100).**

2.20 Supplementary Regulations Part 1

Supplementary Regulations provide information to competitors and drivers in addition to those which are contained in the Motorsport Australia National Competition Rules and the Motorsport Australia Manual. Part 1 of these Supplementary Regulations contains regulations that remain the same for each round this year. They are provided to Championship and Club Series Registrants and are available from the www.supersprintnsw.com website.
