1. EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

1.1 Event Title: 2025 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA NSW Motor Race Championship, Round 4 at Sydney Motorsport Park

This will be a DAY/NIGHT RACE EVENT.

1.2 Date: SATURDAY 26th JULY 2025

1.3 Venue: Sydney Motor Sport Park, – the 3.9 km Gardner (GP) Circuit will be used.

2. ORGANISATION AND STATUS

- 2.1 The Event shall be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Circuit Race Standing Regulations (CRSR) published by Motorsport Australia, relevant Championship and/or Series Sporting and Technical Regulations as approved by Motorsport Australia, these Supplementary Regulations, and any Further Regulations and instructions to Competitors that may be issued.
- 2.2 The Event shall be the NSW State Motor Race Championship Event, with races for the invited categories.
- 2.3 The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au

4. MEDICAL

Medical requirements will be in accordance with Article 3.1.4.3 Alternative Medical Service/Requirements of the Motorsport Australia Medical Service Requirements at Motor Sport Events.

a) Length: 3.9 km

b) Direction: Anti - Clockwise

c) Track Density: The maximum number of starters permitted in any race will be in accordance

with Motorsport Australia guidelines.

d) The Organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to any Competitor in accordance with the NCR.

7. EVENTS

- 7.1 These races will be held in accordance with the 2025 Motorsport Australia Manual and the relevant Sporting & Technical Regulations and appendices for 2025, **Regulations** from **al**l relevant parties at the time of the Event.
- 7.2 Races will be conducted for vehicles complying with Regulations for the following categories;

Formula Cars (38), Formula Ford (47), Formula Vee (54), SuperSports (38), HQ Holdens (54), SuperKarts (60) Production Touring (54) (Enduro)

- 7.3 In order to maximise track time and racing laps for all categories, ARDC in consultation with Motorsport Australia reserve the right to combine events. This will be done with due consideration to the State Championships and the categories concerned. Any such combination will be advised in the Race Event Schedule.
- 7.4 Qualifying will take place on Saturday 26th of JULY 2025.

The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

8. REFUNDS:

- 8.1 If you need to withdraw your entry you must advise the ARDC in writing no later than MONDAY 21st JULY 2025@ COB 17:00hrs. The ARDC will not consider refunds unless this requirement is strictly adhered to. A \$50.00 administration fee will be charged for ALL withdrawals.
- 8.2 If a competitor pays to attend Friday practice, then suffers a mechanical failure which prevents them racing the ARDC will refund 50% of the race Entry Fee if advised in person or email or fax **before 17:00hrs Friday 25th JULY 2025.**

9. LICENCE & MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- 9.1 Competitors must hold a current Motorsport Australia-Affiliated Sporting Car Club Membership unless they comply with 9.2.1 or 9.2.2 below.
- 9.2 Each Driver must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Circuit licence with Provisional Endorsed, unless noted otherwise against a particular Event or specified otherwise in the Sporting Regulations for the relevant category Championship/Series or;
 - 9.2.1 Hold a Motor Sport New Zealand competition licence and valid Tasman Visa for the event or
 - 9.2.2 Hold the minimum of the highest-grade National Licence issued by a foreign ASN required for the Event and obtain approval to compete from the ASN that issued their licence. Each such Driver and Competitor.

- 9.2.2.1 Will be ineligible to score points in a Championship/Cup/Series/Trophy etc. connected with the Event: and
- 9.2.2.2 Shall be required to receive an authorisation to compete from Motorsport Australia prior to the Event.

10. AWARDS/PRIZES

Awards for this Event will be in the form of trophies and will be provided by the Organiser.

They will be awarded as per the relevant category Sporting Regulations, approved by Motorsport Australia for 2025, and in conjunction with the 2025 Motorsport Australia NSW Motor Race Championship Sporting Regulations Chapter 3 – Awards and Pointscores. Round Awards will be presented on the day on the ARDC/SMSP PODIUM, AFTER THE RACE AFTER THEIRS.

11. AUTOMATIC TIMING

The Organisers utilise an automatic timing system that requires all cars to be fitted with a Data 1 transmitter. Competitors must provide the transmitter. Transmitters are available from Dorian Industries, Factory 1, 29 Graham Court, Hoppers Crossing VIC, 3029. Phone: + 61 3 9931 1371.

12. PRIVATE PRACTICE AVAILABILITY

Sydney Motor Sport Park is available for Private Practice on Friday 25th JULY 2025.

Private Practice will commence at 12Noon and conclude at 20:00hrs.

Entry for Private Practice can be made <u>during</u> the Online Entry System process, OR when entries close, on the day.

The GST inclusive cost is \$260 per day/night or \$220 per day/night, to members of the A.R.D.C.

The Closing Date for online entries is MONDAY 14TH JULY 2025 @ COB 17:00hrs.

Entry can be made on the day at a cost of \$310 per day to Non-members, or \$280 per day to members of the A.R.D.C.

13. GARAGE AND PADDOCK ALLOCATION

The On-line Entry System allows the BOOKING & RESERVING of Garages and Carports. **ARDC members are given 1st offer of Garages**, ie they can **BOOK** a garage. Non-members are only allowed to **Reserve** a Garage initially. (If you do receive a Garage it is recommended that you bring your own padlock).

14. CREDENTIALS

14.1 All Competitors should enter Sydney Motor Sport Park via Gate A off Ferrers Road.

Sprint Races - 4 Tickets PER VEHICLE, will be made available for Pit Crew, including the Driver.

These allocations may be updated in any Further Supplementary Regulations that may be issued for this Event.

Pit Lane wristband passes can be issued at Friday practice and will be valid all weekend.

15. TARGETED SCRUTINY

Scrutiny at this Event will be undertaken under the Motorsport Australia Targeted Scrutiny process.

All vehicles must comply with the relevant requirements for their category. The Chief Scrutineer for the Event will determine which vehicles will be audited and those Competitors will be advised of a time in which the audit will occur at Event Documentation Scrutiny. A Motorsport Australia Vehicle Log Book must be presented. Competitors and Drivers must comply with the Motorsport Australia requirements at the time of entry.

All Competitors must wear apparel in compliance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual. All footwear, socks and gloves must comply with FIA 8856-2000 standard.

16. FUEL

98Ron, Elf Race 102 and commercial E85 fuel are available via bowser at all times. The maximum amount of fuel to be stored in each Garage is 250 litres.

- a) Refuelling is not allowed in Pit Lane or in Pit Garages whilst participating in a race or session. Any refuelling done outside this period, must be done in the following manner;
 - Both garage doors must be open.
 - No open flame or ANY type of cigarette can be present.
 - A fire extinguisher must be present under the control of a person appropriately dressed for the function. le fully covered in neck/ankle in non-flammable/flame retardant material.

17. INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia relation to the event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au

18. PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with of the NCR.

19. INTEGRITY

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
